INTRODUCTION

SPEND TIME WITH GOD EACH DAY MARK 1:21-39

- 1. Jesus made spending time with God the priority of His day Mark 1:35
- 2. It is a time to connect with God's Presence, Perspective and Power

Like any relationship, my connection with God grows over time – but I need to invest the time.

3. A heart that loves God "Our Father"

SEEK GOD'S WISDOM AND DISCERNMENT Luke 6:12-19

BACKGROUND – A MAJOR DECSION TO MAKE – NAMING THE 12 APOSTLES

- 1. Jesus did more than ask for guidance He wove prayer throughout the process
 - "Continued in prayer" unceasing, fervent, persevering
- 2. For us, the Bible becomes an important way for God to speak to us
- 3. A heart that is humbly dependent. "Your will be done"

PRAYERFULLY PREPARE TO MEET CHALLENGES Matthew 14:22-33

BACKGROUND – THE DEMANDS OF THE CROWD TO MAKE JESUS KING

- 1. Jesus takes a step back and prays
 - Jesus prayed for Himself How to respond to the crowd
 - Jesus prays for the 12 How they will respond to the crowd walking away
- 2. Praying through Scripture is the key to preparing for the challenges we and others have.

- 3. This is how we pray for ourselves and for others (children, spouse, other believers)
- 4. A heart that is surrendered to God "Your kingdom come"

RECEIVE THE ENABLING GRACE OF GOD TO WALK WITH HIM Mark 14:32-42

BACKGROUND - FACING THE AGONY OF THE CROSS

- 1. Jesus, even in His distress, begins with affirming His relationship with and trust in God the Father 14:36
 - "Abba" Papa, Communicates closeness and affection
- 2. Jesus shares His heart openly and without fear of rejection. 14:36
- 3. Jesus surrenders his will to the will of the Father
- 4. It is the act of surrendering to God that opens our lives to His enabling Grace
- 5. A heart that is prepared for the spiritual battle "Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil"
