1. Why do you think Paul was so upset with Peter? (To get the whole picture read Galatians 2:7-10 & Acts 10) How are Peter's actions in Galatians different from those in Acts 10?
2. How do you think Peter responded to Paul's rebuke. Though we are not given an answer in Galatians, 2 Peter 3:15-17 gives us a clue.
3. What do you think the events of verses 7-14 add to Paul's declaration of justification by faith in verses 15-16. What is the contrast?
4. How may someone be justified by works of the Law? (v.16b)
5. Write in your own words what it means to be justified.
6. What are some implications of being declared righteous by God?
7. Can you do something to make Christ love you more? (v. 20)
8. Is there anything you can do to cause Christ to love you less?
9. In what ways should the truth concerning Christ's love for you impact the way you live?
10. If salvation is through any other avenue besides faith in Christ, what does that say about the death of Christ? (v.21)
