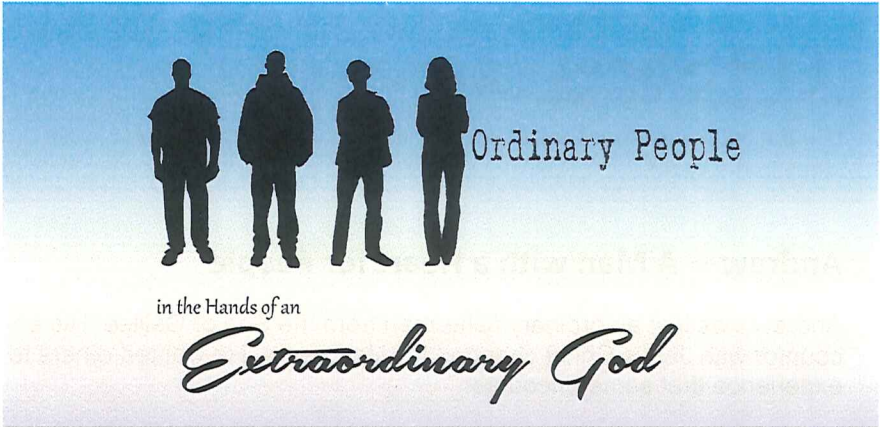

# TIP Sheet (Take It Personal)

Use the below questions to aid you in making personal application of your study in the Word.

## Andrew— A Man with a Heart for People

Andrew was just an ordinary fisherman from the Sea of Galilee. His encounter with Jesus Christ changed his life forever. He wanted others to experience that same encounter.

Pastor Ed mentioned three things Andrew did to introduce his friends to Jesus. Read John 1:40-42 and interact with the questions below.

1. Andrew “**Identified**” (v. 40) people in his Oikos (circle of influence). Think again through the list of people that you know. Who has God has placed in your life so you may share with them Christ story?
2. Not only did Andrew identify those who should hear about Christ, he actually went and “**shared the news**” with them. How would you explain the gospel of Christ to your friends. What are the important points to share with them?

3. The third thing Andrew did was to “**bring**” his brother Peter to actually meet Jesus. Two implications can be drawn from verse 42.
  - 1). Andrew was not satisfied to just tell Peter about Christ he wanted him to experience Christ up-close.
  - 2). Andrew had a personal relationship with Christ and he was living it out.

How would you describe your relationship with Christ? Would others identify you as a Christ follower?

To maximize the impact of our “heart for people” we must imitate Christ. Use Ephesians 5:1-21 to interact with the following three questions.

4. What can you specifically do to love others as Christ has loved you? (Ephesians 5:1-2)
5. Ephesians 5:7-13 tells us Christians are to “live as children of light”. In other words Christ is the “Light of the world” According to these verses what does a child of light do that imitates Christ?
6. Ephesians 5:15-21 exhorts the believer to “live wisely”. From these verses can you identify three wise things that are characteristic of your life?
