

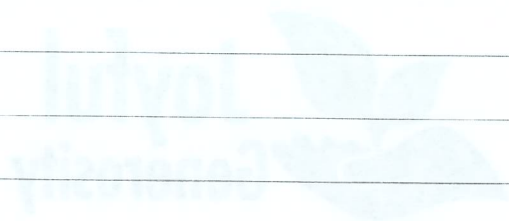

# TIP Sheet (Take It Personal)

Use the below questions to aid you in making personal application of your study in the Word.

1. In the parable about the rich farmer who tore down his buildings to build bigger ones Jesus exhorts us “guard against all covetousness, ...” (Luke 12:13-21). How do you define covetousness?
2. What mistake the rich farmer make?
3. Why are we to guard against covetousness? (Luke 12:15; 22-23)
4. It is likely true that each person has at some point in their life coveted something. How has covetousness expressed itself in your life?

5. What lesson can you learn from the illustration of the ant in Proverbs 6:6-8? "Go to the ant, O sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise. <sup>7</sup>Without having any chief, officer, or ruler, <sup>8</sup> she prepares her bread in summer and gathers her food in harvest."

6. Do you agree that how you use money is a litmus test for one's spiritual condition? Can it be a sign of regeneration? Read the story of Zacchaeus (Luke 19:5-10). How does the rich young ruler demonstrate this principle? (Luke 18:18-23)
