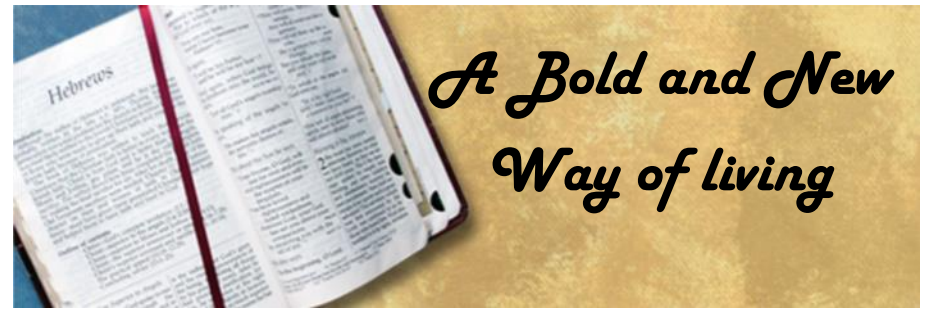


4. What are some ways God has shown His faithfulness to you? Try to be specific. These should become praise items for you.
